Overview

Welcome to the Rally of the Midwinter Moon. This rally is an Atlantic Sports Car Club event that is part of the ARMS Road Rally Championship.

These supplemental Regulations (Sup Regs.) provide additional information and regulations in addition to those found in the governing regulations listed below.

This road rally is a navigational rally. Novice instructions will be simple involving mostly attention to signs and landmarks as well as measured distances. Experienced instructions will be significantly more difficult.

The following equipment are recommended for the event.

- Clipboard, pens, calculator
- Working trip odometer
- Cell phone,
- Water, snacks, blanket, fire extinguisher
- Tow rope, warning triangle, fire extinguisher.
- This is a winter night event. Interior lighting for map reading at night and snow tires are strongly recommended.

Supplementary Regulations

1. This is an ARMS regional rally held under the General Competition Regulations of the Canadian Association of RallySport and the ARMS Navigational Rally Rules. These publications are available online at <https://carsrally.ca/cars-home/> and <http://www.armsinc.ca>. They will also be available for scrutiny at the start.
2. In the event of a conflict between these regulations and those listed in 1, these regulations take precedence.
3. The rally is run on a mix of paved and unpaved public roads.
4. Rally will accept entries in Novice and Experienced classes, as per ARMS Regional Rally Regulations.
5. Most of the route is contained on topographic maps 11E/04 Kennetcook, 11E03 Shubenacadie.
6. Entries/Eligibility: All entrants must be a member of an ARMS affiliated Club. Entries must include the entry form & payment (post dated cheques not accepted) Entries may be e-transferred to the club Treasurer (payments@ascc.ca), or made in person (subject to space limitations) until 1530hrs the day of the event.

8. All participants must complete an electronic waiver. The waiver can be found at: <https://ascc.speedwaiver.com/pldgy> . (A mobile phone with internet connection is required for this.)
9. Valid proof of registration, license and insurance must be presented if requested by a rally official.
10. Entered Vehicles must be Registered, Insured road vehicles. A NAVEX/TSD Self Declaration form must be completed

[f_Declaration_Form_20251226.pdf](#)). Any team with members who are under 18 years of age must have a minor participant waiver completed.

11. References/Units

- 11.1. **Time Reference:** Time is expressed in hours, minutes and seconds and measured to the nearest second.
- 11.2. **Speed Reference:** Unless otherwise stated, speed is expressed in kilometers per hour (KPH).
- 11.3. **Distance Reference:** Distances are expressed in kilometers and measured to the nearest one-hundredth of a kilometer. Distances at turns were measured to the beginning of the turn or edge of the intersection.

12. Awards will be dash plaques for top 3 places in Novice and Experienced classes.

13. Checkpoints. This event will be OPEN CHECKPOINTS. All CP Locations will be a marked vehicle or station with an appropriate CP board.

14. Scoring: Scoring is as described in Annex D of the ARMS Navigational Rally Rules.

- 14.1. Scoring: All cars will be penalized 1 (one) point for each minute early or late at any control. Maximum points for missed control, or maximum early/late penalty at a control for this event is 30 points.
- 14.2. Time out at controls will be the 00 second mark of the 2nd minute following time in (e.g. IN: 3:12:40 OUT: 3:14:00) except where spacing of departures is needed.
- 14.3. Maximum Lateness: Maximum permitted lateness to qualify for check-in at controls will be 30 minutes for the first 2 sections (excluding odometer check), and 45 minutes for subsequent controls except one hour at the final control.
